CHILD POLICY:

Optional hotels in Arusha and airport transfers

- A transfer between Kilimanjaro International Airport and Arusha will cost USD 100 per vehicle, each way
- A night at Impala Hotel Arusha (3 Star) will cost \$70 per person sharing / \$120 per person single, per night on bed & breakfast basis
- A night at Mt. Meru Hotel Arusha (4 Star) will cost \$105 per person sharing / \$175 per person single, per night on bed & breakfast basis

ITINERARY FOR THIS SAFARI –

DAY 1 / Arusha – Tarangire National Park

Pick up from your hotel in Arusha. Transfer to Tarangire, driving through the countryside with villages and farms (160 km / 2 ½ hours).

Dinner and overnight at Tarangire Sopa Lodge.

DAY 2 / Tarangire National Park

Early breakfast, followed by a full day game drive with picnic lunch in Tarangire National Park. The park gets its name from the Tarangire River which runs right through the park. This river is a watering hole for animals during the long, dry season. The Tarangire National Park is reputed to contain some of the largest elephant herds in Africa.

Dinner and overnight at Tarangire Sopa Lodge.

DAY 3 / Tarangire National Park – Central Serengeti

Early breakfast, followed by a morning game drive in Tarangire National Park. The park gets its name from the Tarangire River which runs right through the park. This river is a watering hole for animals during the long, dry season. Return to the lodge for lunch or you may opt for a picnic lunch. After lunch, proceed northwest into the hilly countryside of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. From here lie the vast plains of the Serengeti, where you can start spotting animals well before you get into the park (330 km / 6 hours).

Dinner & overnight at Serengeti Sopa Lodge.

DAY 4 / Central Serengeti

Enjoy a morning and an afternoon game drive exploring the vast Serengeti plains. The name 'Serengeti' means "Endless Plains" in the Masai language. The wildlife defines the Serengeti – Countless zebra, buffalo, gazelle, wildebeest and other species make it their home. The terrain is the main stage for the great wildebeest migration, an awesome spectacle at certain times of the year, involving millions of these beasts.

Breakfast, lunch, dinner & overnight at Serengeti Sopa Lodge.

DAY 5 / Central Serengeti – Ngorongoro Crater

Breakfast at the Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge. Depart from the Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge with picnic lunch boxes, and head towards Ngorongoro crater, passing the Olduvai Gorge, also known as the 'cradle of mankind' en-route.

When you reach the Ngorongoro Highlands, continue to ascend the exterior of the crater reaching its rim and catch your first glimpse of what has often been referred to as the "Eighth Wonder of the World". Arrive at the Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge by mid-afternoon (140 km / 3 ½ hours).

Dinner & overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge.

DAY 6 / Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast, descend the inner wall of the crater to its floor 2,000 feet below. Here is the best game viewing Africa has to offer. The unique eco-system supports a delicate balance of predator and prey in their endless quest for survival. You can carry a picnic lunch to be enjoyed by the hippo pool.

As the sun nears the crater's west rim, return to the comforts of Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge for dinner & overnight.

DAY 7 / Ngorongoro Crater – Arusha

After breakfast, bid farewell to your lodge. Depart with packed lunch boxes and head to Arusha (210 km / 4 hours).

Drop off at your hotel.
