

Safari prices include:

- 1 night accommodation at Lake Manyara Serena Lodge or Lake Manyara Safari Lodge (Lake Manyara)

ITINERARY FOR THIS SAFARI –

DAY 1 / Arusha – Lake Manyara National Park

- 2:00 pm: Pick up from your hotel in Arusha. Transfer to Lake Manyara, driving through the countryside with villages and farms (130 km / 2 ½ hours).
- Dinner and overnight at your lodge.

DAY 2 / Lake Manyara National Park – Central Serengeti

- Early breakfast followed by a morning game drive in Lake Manyara National Park, host to a variety of bird life, hippos and several troupe of baboon. Return to your lodge for lunch.
- After lunch, proceed northwest into the hilly countryside of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. From here lie the vast plains of the Serengeti, where you can start spotting animals well before you get into the park (200 km / 4 hours).
- Dinner & overnight at your lodge.

DAY 3 – DAY 4 / Central Serengeti

- Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight at your lodge
- Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives, or a full day game drive with a packed lunch.
- The name 'Serengeti' means "Endless Plains" in the Masai language. The wildlife defines the Serengeti – Countless zebra, buffalo, gazelle, wildebeest and other species make it their home, while lion, cheetah and leopard follow as easy pickings are to be found.

DAY 5 / Central Serengeti – Ngorongoro Crater

- Breakfast at your Lodge. Depart from your lodge with picnic lunch boxes, and head towards Ngorongoro crater, passing the Olduvai Gorge, also known as the 'cradle of mankind' en-route.
- When you reach the Ngorongoro Highlands, continue to ascend the exterior of the crater reaching its rim and catch your first glimpse of what has often been referred to as the "Eighth Wonder of the World". *****Note: If staying at Karatu, then the ascent to the crater rim will be done on the day you take your full day game drive***** Arrive at your by mid-afternoon (140 km / 3 ½ hours).
- Dinner & overnight at your lodge

DAY 6 / Ngorongoro Crater

- After breakfast, descend the inner wall of the crater to its floor 2,000 feet below. Here is the best game viewing Africa has to offer. The unique eco-system supports a delicate balance of predator and prey in their endless quest for survival. You can carry a picnic lunch to be enjoyed by the hippo pool.
- As the sun nears the crater's west rim, return to the comforts of your lodge for dinner & overnight.

DAY 7 / Ngorongoro Crater – Arusha

- After breakfast, bid farewell to your lodge and head to Arusha (210 km / 4 hours).
- Drop off at your hotel.
