## ITINERARY FOR THIS SAFARI –

### **DAY 1 / Kilimanjaro/Arusha – Tarangire National Park**

Pick up from Kilimanjaro International Airport or your hotel in Arusha. Lunch in Arusha.

2:00 pm: Transfer to Tarangire, driving through the countryside with villages and farms (140 km / 3 hours).

Dinner and overnight at your lodge.

### **DAY 2 / Tarangire National Park**

Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight at your lodge.

Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives in Tarangire National Park. The park gets its name from the Tarangire River which runs right through the park. This river is a watering hole for animals during the long, dry season.

(You can opt to return to your lodge for a hot lunch, or take a full day game drive with a packed lunch.)

### **DAY 3 / Tarangire National Park – Central Serengeti**

After breakfast, depart your lodge with packed lunch boxes and drive to the vast plains of the Serengeti, where you can start spotting animals well before you get into the park (320 km / 7 hours).

Dinner & overnight at your lodge.

### **DAY 4 – DAY 5 / Central Serengeti**

Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight at your lodge

Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives, or a full day game drive with a packed lunch.

The name 'Serengeti' means "Endless Plains" in the Masai language. The wildlife defines the Serengeti – Countless zebra, buffalo, gazelle, wildebeest and other species make it their home, while lion, cheetah and leopard follow as easy pickings are to be found.

### **DAY 6 / Central Serengeti – Ngorongoro Crater**

Breakfast at your Lodge. Depart from your lodge with picnic lunch boxes, and head towards Ngorongoro crater, passing the Olduvai Gorge, also known as the 'cradle of mankind' en-route.

When you reach the Ngorongoro Highlands, continue to ascend the exterior of the crater reaching its rim and catch your first glimpse of what has often been referred to as the "Eighth Wonder of the World". Arrive at your by mid-afternoon (155 km / 3 ½ hours).

Dinner & overnight at your lodge

### **DAY 7 / Ngorongoro Crater**

After breakfast, descend the inner wall of the crater to its floor 2,000 feet below. Here is the best game viewing Africa has to offer. The unique eco-system supports a delicate balance of predator and prey in their endless quest for survival. You can carry a picnic lunch to be enjoyed by the hippo pool.

As the sun nears the crater's west rim, return to the comforts of your lodge for dinner & overnight.

### **DAY 8 / Ngorongoro Crater – Arusha/Kilimanjaro**

After breakfast, bid farewell to your lodge and head to Arusha City (180 km / 3 ½ hours) for lunch. Drop off at your hotel in Arusha, or continue to Kilimanjaro International Airport (50 km / 1 hour)
